• CONNECT AND OPERATE



- 1. Install Audacity onto your computer
- 2. Connect an analog audio source to the PACAPT1 using either the RCA or 3.5mm connection
- 3. Connect a computer to the other end of the PACAPT1 using the USB connection, the computer will automatically install the required drivers for the PACAPT1
- 4. Open Audacity to capture audio and music to your computer, Audacity allows for further editing if needed
- 5. Save the audio files as a digital format such as MP3

• AUDACITY

Audacity is a free and open-source digital audio editor and recording application software, available for Windows, macOS, Linux, and other Unix-like operating systems. This software allows you to take analog audio from the PACAPT1 to edit and save into a digital format for multiple uses.
